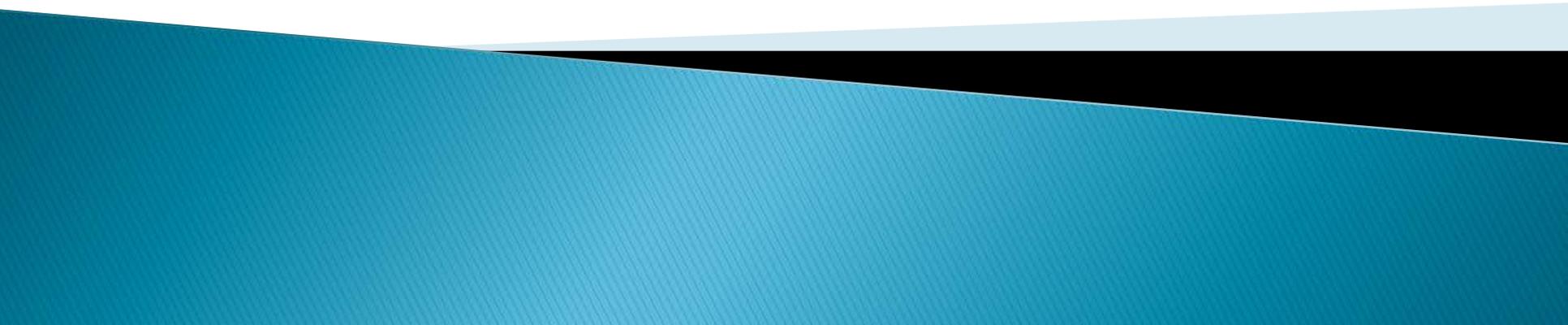





Do you believe that Latino based agencies are sufficiently funded to address Latino health Issues?


Do you agree that transportation is still a barrier for Latinos to access health services?












