Ohio's State Opioid Response (SOR) Grant Program

As part of Ohio's SOR grant program, OhioMHAS is seeking applicants for *FY2020 Ohio Opiate Response Continuum Grant for Organizations Serving Members of African American, Hispanic/Latino American, and Other Minority Communities*. Funding is available for programs and projects that will increase access to treatment and recovery support for community members with a primary or secondary diagnosis of opioid use disorder or those with a documented history of opiate related overdose. **Deadline is March 6th.** [Apply here.](#)



Special Events Support Program

The City of Columbus, the Columbus Recreation and Park Department is offering funding for special events, such as festivals, neighborhood and heritage/cultural celebrations. Fatherhood Single County Implementation Grant

The Ohio Commission on Fatherhood (OCF) seeks to award funding to organizations to implement a comprehensive countywide approach to promoting responsible fatherhood.
