State leaders are working on proposing policy to help shield non-profits from the devastating effects of the pandemic. A bill known as the [Protecting Nonprofits from Catastrophic Cash Flow Strain Act](#) has now passed the house as well as the senate. Support Community Farmers Grant



The Department of Agriculture is offering funding to assist community driven non-profits to develop state and local leadership programs to support farmers and ranchers in persistent poverty locations. The maximum amount of federal funding available is \$450,000 over a 3 year period. All applicants must submit by August 24th, 2020. [Apply here](#).

Women in Apprenticeships Grant

The Women's Bureau at the United States Department of Labor is offering grant awards between \$350,000-\$750,000 to organizations that want to support employers and unions in training and hiring women to apprenticeship based positions. Women have been classically underrepresented in these roles. [Apply here](#) by August 3rd, 2020.

OH CARES II Grant

Ohio Humanities is offering relief funding up to \$5,000 in order for community serving non-profits to cover expenses where assistance may be needed due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Eligible organizations must support initiatives related to history, heritage, language, linguistics, literature, or other humanities. Application opens July 31st and closes on August 14th.
